Publishing activity

After 1989 she was involved in the social, civic and political life from Romania, writing articles of general interests, and on contemporary Romanian life. Her literary activity aims mainly towards poetry and translations from the world's philosophical and spiritual literature.

Some of her poems have been translated in English, German, Spanish, French, Portuguese, Dutch, Italian, Serbian, Chinese, Hungarian, Latin, Hebrew, Polish, Turkish and Urdu, and have been published in literary magazines from Romania and also from abroad (Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Cuba, El Salvador, Estonia, Germany, Italy, Hungary, Mexico, Nicaragua, Pakistan, Poland, Serbia, Spain, Taiwan, Turkey, USA).

Also she had published in literary magazines various translations of the contemporary poetry from Argentina, Austria, Brazil, Belgium, Bolivia, Chile, Colombia, Estonia, Italy, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Portugal, Peru, Puerto Rico, Spain, Taiwan, USA.
